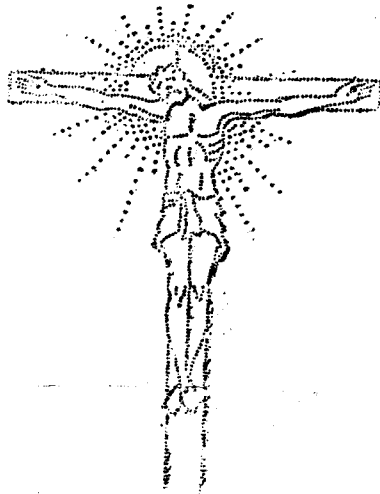

Dear Friends,
