MAY I add a postscript to your obituary (January 9) of Sir Roger Ormrod? In addition to his many other concerns Sir Roger was strongly committed to the improvement of housing conditions in West London, and was for more than 20 years chairman of the Notting Hill Housing Trust.

He presided over the growth of the Trust from its early days until it had become one of the largest and most effective housing associations in London. By the time he retired from the chairmanship in 1988 the belt of squalid rented housing, which ran through North Kensington in the Rachman era, had been transformed.
