7 June 1925

If I die in Capri, I wish to be buried in one of my ordinary night-gowns & in as plain a coffin with as little expense as possible. I would like a sunny corner in the little cemetery, with space left for one or two by my side & a simple stone cross with the words -

"Looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life"

John 21.

If possible, I would like Plot 52 (a double plot) or if not, No. 23.

All my property & personal effects
will belong to my daughters & they will,
I feel sure, know my wishes & dispose
of personal belongings in the most useful
way for themselves & others (clothing &
servants or others as they think best).

Also, when my affairs are settled,
some slight acknowledgment to my
Trustees in remembrance of an old
friend.

Most of my valuables are already
given to my children.

The Pastel Portrait of myself by Brochant
is to be kept by Bonnie & Hilda, & after-
wards pass to Sybil & her children.

To Sybil I leave my brooch with pendant
diamonds & pearls set in gold - & my
necklace of crystal beads.

To my grandsons Raymond & Nigel
I am now giving 2 pictures which I
think they will prize & books.

Items banked with Hilda's are at her disposal, or Bonnie's for their benefit (with exception of brooch & necklace above named).

A box of books & MSS in care of Mr. Arthur Jackson, 24 Austin Friars I leave at the disposal of Bonnie & Hilda or whichever may survive.

In the box is a MS. copy by my late husband of the unique O.T. MS. in the Halle University Library. This I wish to be presented to Trinity Coll., Cambridge or wherever my Trustees think it will be most useful. This has been presented to Trinity

Also, I leave to Bonnie & Hilda or whichever may survive, all monies in my name in Lloyds Bank, 35 Piccadilly, which remain after expenses paid - & property in War Loan (£1500 at present time) & £50 Victory Loan, Securities of which are in Lloyds Bank (where also is deposited

my box of Securities) - A small sum in Italian War Loan (2400 lire at present) in the hands of Messrs Holmes & Co of Naples.

These items are for Bonnie & Hilda or survivor.

Sybil & her children are well-provided for & she will, I am sure, see the justice of this preference.

I commit my soul to the mercy of God, the Father, the Son & the Holy Spirit in whom I place all my faith, in sure & certain hope of forgiveness for all my sins & a joyful resurrection to eternal life.

I commend my dear ones to our loving Father in heaven, & look forward to our reunion in the home above.
