

Hildegarde Hinde (née Ginsburg) was in Africa
with her husband in the early years of 20th century.

Emile Calonne Mackinder (née Ginsburg) was older sister
of Hildegarde, & probably also knew S Africa briefly
about the same time.

The inked alterations to the earlier script are
in E.M.C.'s handwriting. These two sisters lived together
(both having separated from their husbands) for the
remainder of their lives (about 1912 — deaths in 1955
to 1962 (approximately)).

The later retyping (Top 6p) is clearly on a modern
typewriter & done by an experienced typist.

H.H. & E.M.C. were the elder sisters (by 8 + 10 years)
of Sybil Gwendolyn Spottiswoode-Aitken-Lamb, mother
of Raymond & Nigel Spottiswoode (John S. died in WW I 1914)
General Aitken died in 1922/3.. Francis Lamb died
in 1950, & Sybil died 2 weeks later.
